Since school will be closed for the rest of the school year, I will continue to learn through distance learning.






Distance learning is different! It takes a while to get used to seeing my teacher or friends on my computer or tablet.

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There are some tips that can help me learn online.












It is best if I wear a shirt when I'm doing a video chat with my teacher and class.

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Also, if I stay in front of the screen, it will be easier for my teacher and friends to see me.


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I need a break




If I need a break from looking at the screen, I can tell my mom, dad or family member. They will help me take a little break and then come back to my class..


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Sometimes, my teacher might ask me to turn my "mic" off or on.

An adult can help me find this button when I need it.


